1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

That Avard's Supermoto Promotions hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct OPEN SUPERMOTO for SUPERMOTO MACHINES and demonstration Quads at the Raleigh International Raceway on Sunday 6th March 2005.

2. JURISDICTION:

2.1. The above-mentioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling NSW Limited (MNSW) who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National Competition Licences.

2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCRs), these Supplementary Regulations, the By-Laws of MNSW and any Final Instructions.

BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. ENTRIES:

3.1. Entries open forthwith and close last mail **Friday 25th Feb 2005, MAIL IS PREFERED DUE TO THE HIGH COSTS OF THIS MEETING. Late entries or Fax entry's will incur \$20 late fee.**

If entry is FAX please remember to bring original to sign on.

3.2. In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, Avards Supermoto Promotions may retain all or any part of the entry fee, if such retention is approved by MNSW.

3.3. Only entries received on the official Entry Form, which the correct fee accompanies, will be accepted.

3.4. NOTE:- THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE PROMOTER

4. INSURANCE:

4.1. National Capital Benefits Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.

4.2. Personal Accident and Ambulance Insurance is the responsibility of the individual.

4.3. IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE DUE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT SUCH INSURANCE COVER.

6.1. **\$90.00 SENIORS.** Each class.

\$30.00 EXTRA All Powers International.

\$80.00 JUNIORS

Quads: \$90. Includes Day Licence.

6.2. Payment by CHEQUE OR MONEY ORDER only. ANY FEES FOR DISHONoured CHEQUES WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT.

7. ENTRY PASSES:

7.1. THERE WILL BE 2 PASSES PER ENTRY.

Passes picked up Saturday or Sunday at Front Gate.

7.2. NO PASSES MUST PAY AT THE GATE

8.A. AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:

8.1. TROPHY'S TO 3RD PLACE.

8.2. TROPHY'S TO 5TH PLACE in junior class

8.3. ALL COMBINED CLASSES WILL BE SCORED SEPARATELY.

8.B. CLASSES OF COMPETITION:

Race	Class	Details
1	S1	301cc + 2 stroke, 451 + 4 stroke 1 cyl, only 17" wheels and clubman depending on entries
2	S2	126cc to 300cc 2 stroke, 251cc to 450cc 4 stroke 1 cyl, 17" wheels and clubman depending on entries
3	S3	up to 125 2 stroke, up to 250 4 stroke, no wheel restriction, maybe combined depending on entries
4	Club	Clubman riders, no wheel restriction, All powers. No A,B, Pro or Expert Graded riders from any other Disciplines
5	Vets	For riders turning 38 years + in 2005. Bikes, wheels or brakes no restrictions
6	All Powers International	All powers, all grades, no wheel, restriction, no juniors.
7	Juniors	up to 125cc 2 stroke, up to 250cc 4 stroke, 13yrs up to 16yrs. No GP.
8	Quads	Non - Competition class for quad machines. Over 16yrs. Demonstration EVENT ONLY.

9. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

9.1. To constitute a Class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each Class shall be 12 for solos

ENTRIES PER CLASS MINIMUM

9.2. Should there be insufficient entries in any Class of Competition, the decision to run or cancel the Class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and/or prize money, will be at the discretion of Promoter subject to MNSW approval.

9.3. A Senior rider can only enter one of the main classes, but can submit a request to fill places in a class if numbers allow.

10. RACE FORMAT:

10.1. A 15 minute Qualifying sessions on Sunday per class.

10.2 Each senior class will receive 3 races. Juniors 4 races over 6 laps

10.3. Challenge will be over heats with top 5 Each Heat to finals over 2 x 10 laps. The Last chance will be over 6 laps with the top 2 from each heat to the final. 1 Rider at Promoters Discretion.

11. MACHINES AND RIDERS:

11.1. All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs for Supermoto Competition.

11.2. Multiple entry of the one Machine in the same Class of Competition is not permitted. Only one class and all powers Permitted per rider.

11.3 Machine may be changed if scrutineered and notify the Clerk of course 15min prior to the start of your race. Riders numbers must be on all three (3) number plates.

12. RIDING NUMBERS:

12.1. Competitors will be allocated their MNSW Registered Riding Number or their preferred Riding Number. All others shall be allocated numbers at the Promoter's discretion.

12.2. All numberplates' on all Machines MUST comply with the GCRs.

13. GRID POSITIONS:

13.1. Will be by your time in qualifying or at promoter's discretion for the first moto, then as per finishing order.

14. RIDERS BRIEFING:

A Riders' Briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing and ALL Competitors MUST attend Riders' Briefing. Sign On sheets must be signed by the competitor as confirmation of attendance.

15. DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

By order of MNSW, random drug &/or alcohol testing of participants (i.e. officials, competitors, mechanics, pit crew and any other person associated with the control, direction

and operation of the competition) may take place prior to, or at any time during this meeting.

16. CODE OF CONDUCT:

All Competitors, Officials and Parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia By-Law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCRs) which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all Motorcycle Race Meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and shall be enforced.

For the purposes of drug & alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be 7:30am, with the completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has finished his/her racing schedule.

18. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

Raleigh International Supermoto Circuit is Approx. 900m of tarmac and 150m of dirt with 2 jumps.

19. STARTS:

All competitions will be from a clutch start and as stipulated in GCR 6.9.7.2 and the track licence. Machines will be grided four per row. Light will be on for up to 5 seconds, then when the light goes out racing will start.

Jump-starts will be penalised with 10 second Penalty

20. RACING:

Laps: All races and heats will be 7 LAPS.

2 x International Challenge Finals will be Ten (10) Laps ea.

Last Chance Over 6 Laps.

21. NOISE:

All machines must comply with the requirements of the Track Licence.

All Machines must comply with a 95db ride by at 30M as required by the E.P.A and GCRs, any machine not complying will be black-flagged.

22. TIMING:

This event will be electronically timed so each rider will have to hire a transmitter at \$20.00. When you collect your transmitter there will be a **Deposit** of \$50.00 required which we will hold till transmitter is returned in good order. You will also be required to sign a rental agreement.

23. GST:

The Goods and Services Tax affects the payment of prize money. If you do not provide an ABN or declare the sport is a hobby, the Promoter may withhold 48.5% of prize money over \$50.00, which is otherwise payable to you. Please tick one of the boxes on the entry form and if appropriate provide your ABN to ensure the full amount of prize money is paid.

24. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

24.1. ADMISSION: \$20 ADULT \$10 KIDS 5-15yrs, PENSIONERS Kids under 5yrs free \$45 FAMILY

WARNING! THIS IS AN IMPORTANT DOCUMENT WHICH AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS. READ IT CAREFULLY AND DO NOT SIGN IT UNLESS YOU ARE SATISFIED YOU UNDERSTAND IT.

IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to compete, observe, work for, or participate in any way in the EVENT(S) or being permitted to enter for any purpose any RESTRICTED AREA (defined as any area requiring special authorisation, credentials, or permission to enter or any area to which admission by the general public is restricted or prohibited), EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED, for himself, his personal representatives, heirs, and next of kin:

1. Acknowledges, agrees, and represents that he has or will immediately upon entering any such RESTRICTED AREAS, and will continuously thereafter, inspect the RESTRICTED AREAS which he enters and he further agrees and warrants that, if at any time, he is in or about RESTRICTED AREAS and feels anything to be unsafe, he will immediately advise the officials of such and will leave the RESTRICTED AREAS and/or refuse to participate further in the EVENT(S).
