Rule 8.5 Junior Competition Classes

15 Years - SS600

Eligible 15-year-olds permitted to compete in the Supersport 600 Class (SS600)

Explanation:

The MA Board, Road Race Commission and Rules & Technical committee have announced that eligible 15-year-old competitors will be permitted to compete in the SS600 class for 2019.

Junior competitors will need to be endorsed by an RCB in the same way they are endorsed for "13 to U16 to race with seniors". This requires the junior to be assessed by an RCB accredited Coach who will determine if the competitor is competent to be in the SS600 class. The coach will then inform the RCB of the junior's competency and the RCB will include the endorsement on the rider's license.

The introduction of this new endorsement creates an opportunity for current Road Race endorsed 15-year-old competitors to move into the SS600 class one year earlier and to gain valuable experience prior to moving into other classes in the future. It also allows for a clearer progression path for up and coming junior competitors to hone their skills in this discipline.
